





HALF NOTE	 = 2 beats



Adjust your right arm to play on the correct string.

3. D AND A







★ Check your bow grip often.

4. HALF NOTES



★ Move the bow slower for half notes.



<p>WHOLE REST</p>  <p>= 4 beats of silence</p>	<p>REPEAT SIGN</p>  <p>Repeat the previous section of music again.</p>	<p>DOWN BOW</p>  <p>Move the bow toward the tip.</p>	<p>UP BOW</p>  <p>Move the bow toward the frog.</p>
